
Red Oak



The Red Oak is one of the most important oaks for timber production in North America. Quality red oak is of high value as lumber and veneer, while defective logs are used as firewood. Being the most commonly used hardwood in North America, red oak's uses are extensive, including mine timbers, railroad ties, architectural interiors, flooring, millwork, cabinetry, plywood, coffins, pallets and more. The bark in red oak is rich in tannin, used in tanning leather. Supplies of red oak are plentiful and because it's one of the faster growing species of oak, chances are it will remain widely available and inexpensive for years to come.

Grading System

SPF Lumber is graded in the same way in all parts of Canada, according to the rules written by the National Lumber Grades Authority (NLGA).
